New Functionality

Work with Cobwebb Subsystem

This is a new option 8 on the main CPPD menu to call the program [WRKCSBS](#) which allows you to work with all the jobs that normally run in the Cobwebb subsystem. It has the following functionality:

- Display all the jobs that run in the Cobwebb subsystem even if the subsystem is not active
- If the Cobwebb subsystem is **active** you have the following options:
 - **Stop** and **Start** individual jobs
 - Work with an individual active job
 - Change the **switches** for **Test** and **Trace** modes and / or the **logging severity** for an active job
- **Stop** and **Start** the subsystem
- Configure the jobs running in the system by pressing **F18** to call [CFGCSBS](#)

Note: In order for this program to work successfully we have prevented the creation of duplicate Data Queue Names in different libraries in [Work with Spooled File Monitor](#).

Cobwebb Queue - Allow for multiple attachments to an email

Up to now you have only been able to send an email with multiple attachments directly to the SMTP Mail Server and not via the Cobwebb Queue. That has all changed, and you can now add additional attachments either by using the **%A** variable in the email **Subject** and retrieving the attachment file path(s) from the [Cobwebb General Directory](#) or by writing a [Cobwebb Email Exit program](#).

Note: You will not currently be able to see these extra attachments when viewing the Cobwebb Queue but they exist, with their Queue Reference as a link, in the AFAXQAT file with the attachments being stored in the **Additional Attachments** folder under the [Email parameters](#).

New Exit Programs

Print a stream file

[COBPRTSTMF](#) prints a file on the IFS or QNTC to an Output Queue on the IBM i.

Validate a file path

[COBCHKPATH](#) validates a file path on the IFS or QNTC.

Compare two dates

[COBCOMPDAT](#) compares two dates and returns GT, LT, or EQ depending on whether the **From date** is Greater Than, Less Than or Equal to the **To date**.

Send email with multiple destinations and attachments direct

[COBMULTATT](#) sends an email to multiple recipients, including multiple attachments. The email is sent using [SNPPPEML3](#) which sends the email directly to your SMTP Mail Server and not via the Cobwebb Queue. All the details for the email such as Subject, Message, Email Address etc. are populated using various parameters in the exit program.

Enhancements

- Working with **XML Cross References** [WRKXMLX](#) now caters for one sub list i.e. if you had several invoice line elements and each invoice line had several quantity elements.
- The [WRKQCPY](#) command now copies the document as well as the AFAXQ entry in case the original entry is deleted.
- Prevent duplicate **Data Queue** names being created in different libraries in [WRKSPLM](#) as this causes issues for the new [Work with Cobwebb Subsystem](#).
- [COBSPLATR](#) has been extended to return more spool file attributes.
- [COBCHKEML](#) now includes some domain validation.
- [RTVPRTE](#) has been updated to include an option to write the printer file information to a CSV file.
- Added a check in the [ADVRFMT *LAST](#) call to validate the **Output Queue name** and **library** and, if not valid, revert to the default of **QPRINT** in library **CPPD**.
- [Email parameters](#) now include a new page to configure the **Additional Attachments folder** for storing additional attachments for an email.
- The [print of failed emails](#) now includes the:
 - o Call cancel code
 - o SMTP error code
 - o PPD Name
- **POSTIE3 - Sends email:**
 - o v3.7.01 and above. Only applies the **Translate** and **Trim** parameters to the original attachment generated by the Cobwebb Design and not any additional attachments.
 - o v3.7.00 and above. When **%ATTACHMENT** is used as the [Email Output Device Message](#) it now only adds the first attachment to the body of the email and all others are added as attachments.

- **CHTTPD - Cobwebb Web Server:**
 - v4.81 and above. Added permissions to cookies to allow sharing across different server URLs when CORS (Cross-Origin Resource Sharing) is enabled.
 - v4.79 and above. Docstore SSO (Single Sign-On) integration for Infor System i Workspace AnyWhere. This includes a new Docstore [Server Configuration](#) entry **Token refresh threshold** for refreshing the IBM i Token for accessing Docstore.
 - The favicon for the Cobwebb Web Service has been updated.

Fixes

- **CHTTPD - Cobwebb Web Server:**
 - v4.80 and above. The **CHTTPD Message URL Interface** (which allows you to send an email message via the Cobwebb Web Server) no longer reports a 773 error "This message is not RFC 5322 compliant. There are multiple To headers".
 - v4.73 and above. Correctly frees the HTTPS network context in clientSocketTLS which was causing access to Docstore using HTTPS becoming unresponsive.
 - v4.72 and above. The **Cobwebb Web Service** now returns decimal values between 0 and 1.
- **Docstore - Cobwebb Archive:**
 - v4.72 and above: Fixed an issue where the **Delete** link was not working after successfully manually uploading a document.
 - The **docStoreStore.xsl** has been updated so that, if you browse directly to a Docstore Document Type, the Document Type is now set correctly.

New Functionality

Configure CPPD Subsystem Jobs

This is a new option on the main CPPD menu to call the program [CFGCSBS](#) which allows you to configure the jobs that run in the CPPD subsystem that are based on switches, i.e. they may be enabled/disabled by entering a **Y** or **N** respectively. These switches may also be found on other menu options but this option consolidates those most commonly used.

Work with Held Email Queue entries

Say you wish to test that the email output from a Cobwebb Design (PPD) is correct before you go live and send the email to external recipients but you don't want to have to change the Email Output Device details in the PPD to perform the test.

Firstly you run the PPD in [Test Mode](#) which will automatically hold any email output on the Cobwebb Queue without you having to actually change the Email Output Device in the PPD.

Now you can view the Cobwebb Queue via the [Work with Queue](#) and check that the Recipient information is correct (Option 1) but you cannot see what the attachment looks like without sending the email to yourself.

[WRKHLDQ](#) allows you to review these held emails and enter a different recipient email address & name, say your own, so that you can check if the attachment is correct. It will also remove any additional email addresses that may have been written to the Cobwebb Queue so that only one email is sent.

F1 - Linking to the on-line User Guide

5250 Users (green on black screen) can now use the F1 key, from the Cobwebb Server software, to display the relevant page in the online [Cobwebb Document Management User Guide](#). Prior to this, a Help window was displayed with a URL to the main index page of the guide, which you had to click on. **Note:** This does not include IBM i commands or the main CPPD and CFAX400 menus, as they already have their own built-in help.

The browser used is the one configured as the System Default, **F8** from the [Work with Docstore Hot Keys](#), where the supplied default is Google Chrome. **Note:** The only browsers that currently support this functionality are Chrome, Firefox and Internet Explorer.

New Exit Programs

Advanced Reformatting Utility Pre-paginator

[ADVPREPAGE](#) pre-processes the pagination for detail lines (*DET) being passed to the [Advanced Reformatting Utility](#) (ADVRFMT). This can be useful if you have a varying number of lines for a specific Item in your spooled file and you want to keep them on the same page.

Validate an Email address

[COBCHKEML](#) performs basic validation of an email address.

Return multiple records using SQL

[COBSQLM](#) allows you to retrieve more than one record using a SQL Select statement.

Enhancements

- [Work with XML Cross References](#) has a new **3=Copy** function and designing printed output has new functionality such as:
 - The **9=Design** option allows you specify wrapping for a field that is too long, adding a space before a heading.

- o The **6=Print** option allows you to specify Label IDs that you wish to use as headings on subsequent pages. This is also reflected in the [PRTXMLSPL](#) command and the [FMXML2SPL](#) Folder monitor.
- When running a Cobwebb Design through the [Spooled File Monitor](#) the Library List is reset, prior to processing each Cobwebb Design, to the Library List for the job's Job Description. This prevents issues where a library has been added to the Library List via an Exit program but has not been removed afterwards. When libraries are added via the Cobwebb Design these are automatically removed at the end of the process.
- [COBGENLIBL](#) now clears its store of library names when called with **ADD** in case a previous design has not specified the **RMV** call.
- Exit program [COBSPLATR](#) has a new **Date Format** option of **SYS** to return the spooled file create date using the System Value QDATFMT, when passing ***DATE** in PARM6.
- The [Work with Spooled File Monitor](#) has the following enhancements:
 - o all **Filters** now cater for an asterisk wild card at the end of the string, so entering 'TEST*' for a filter would return any entries with 'TEST' as the first four characters.
 - o a new **Filter** for **PPD Name**.
 - o a new **Option 6=Work with SPLFs** to display all spooled files matching the entry.
 - o the **Copy** function now correctly validates the new entries.
- The [Work with Queue](#) now allows you to change the email type for additional email entries to **TO**. Previously only **CC** and **BCC** were allowed for the additional entries. Also, for email entries, the **PPD Member Name** and **Output Device** that generated the email is displayed when you select option 1 and page down.
- When selecting to delete a PPD via [Work with PPD](#) a confirmation dialog is now displayed letting you know if the PPD is used in any [Spooled File Monitors](#) with an **F23= Confirm** required before deleting the PPD and any Spooled File Monitors.
- The [Cobwebb Web Server](#) has a new configuration option **HTTPS Key password** so that the **HTTPS Key file** can be protected by the password. This allows for private keys which are password protected.

Fixes

- Fixed an issue with the [Advanced Reformatting Utility](#) which was skipping to the supplied Trailer line (*FIRST call PARM3) even when no Trailer (*TRL) records had been supplied.
- Deleting an email entry from the [Cobwebb Queue](#) now also removes any **Additional email** entries.
- Add validation when copying an entry in [WRKSPLM](#).
- Docstore no longer allows duplicate key values even when [Unique](#) is set to **Yes** - fixed in CHHTTPD v4.56 and above.
- Fixed an issue where the [SNDPPDEML3](#) command was not happy with '-' in the **SMTP Authentication UserId**.
- [COBSNDEML](#) now correctly passes in the **SMTP username** and **password** from the [Email parameters](#).

New Folder Monitor Program

Direct Email of documents to your SMTP Mail Server

If you wish to send a document, designed using the Cobwebb Designer, to multiple email addresses as individual emails and you have no idea how many addresses may be required for each document, then this is not achievable using the power of the Cobwebb Designer alone.

- The first **Cobwebb Design** is used to write the Email details to a .TXT file, retrieving the email addresses from wherever they are held.
- The second **Cobwebb Design** generates the PDF output required as the attachment for the email. Both files are written to the same folder and have the same name aside from the extension e.g. ABC001.TXT and ABC001.PDF.
- Then a **Folder Monitor**, calling [FMEMAIL](#) with the ***STD** Monitor Type is used to process the .TXT and .PDF files and send the email(s) directly to your SMTP Mail Server.

New Job Launcher Program

Release Scheduled Email

The [CHGAFAQXQ Job Launcher Monitor](#), to be used with the ***STD** Launcher Type, sets the **Defer Delivery Date** and **Time** and releases an Email on the Cobwebb Queue, based on the Date / Time variables supplied in the Email Output Device of your Cobwebb Design.

New Work with PPD Routeing

[PPD Routeing](#) allows you to configure Printer and Email override details based on up to four pieces of information, supplied by your Cobwebb Design (PPD), via a new Exit Program [COBGETRTG](#). These details are held by **PPD Name** and **Environment / Company** to make it easier if you have different Environments / Companies requiring different output. It allows you to configure complex scenarios outside of a PPD using Equal to, Less than or Equal to, Greater than or Equal to, Less than and Greater than, via an ordered sequence of checks. When a match is found then that is the override that is used.

[Work with PPD Routeing](#) has been added to the [PPD file maintenance](#) menu - **option 7** to replace **Work with Standard Text** as this is also under the CFA400 [Maintenance menu](#) options.

New Exit Programs

Return Hex Values

[COBHEX](#) is useful if you need to output hexadecimal data, say as 'control characters' for a barcode. It is impossible to specify these 'control characters' in the Cobwebb Designer and get them transferred successfully to the IBM i. Control characters are all the values between 0x00 and 0xFF that are not standard characters such as A-Z, 0-9 etc.

Wrap Text

[COBWRAP](#) can be used to wrap data from the spooled file, or hard coded in the Cobwebb Design, into fewer or more lines in your output depending upon your requirement.

The data passed in PARMs 1 - 4 has the leading and trailing blanks trimmed and is then concatenated with a single space between each parameter. The data is then wrapped to the length specified in PARM6.

Retrieve PPD Routeing details

[COBGETRTG](#) will return the routeing entry details, configured in [Work with PPD Routeing](#), based on the supplied parameters. If a comparison match is found then this will be used otherwise the values from the **Default** entry will be returned.

Remove Blank lines

If you have addresses on your spooled file containing blank lines [COBRMVLIN](#) will remove these blank lines.

Handle Multiple Email Addresses for a document

We have written two new exit programs to handle multiple email addresses for a document in a Cobwebb Design, up to a maximum of 20. First there is the **Standard Exit Program** [COBMULTEML](#) to write each email address for the document to a temporary file (with a unique key for the document). If you are using an Advanced Reformatting PPD then you would need to write this unique key to the generated spooled file.

Then there is an **Email Exit Program** [GETMULTEML](#) where you pass this unique key as the [Destination Address](#) element. The program will retrieve the first email address from the file to use as the main email on the Cobwebb Queue and the following will be additional email addresses. These additional email addresses can be TO, CC or BCC as required.

Enhancements

- Added the ability to specify a **Code page** (PARM4) for translating Input and Output parameters for [IMG2CRG](#). Also, if there is an error creating the image, PARM4 will be correctly returned as blank and not left with the input value.
- Added an **F6=Print** option to the [RTVPRTF](#) command.
- New command **ARCFTPLOG** to archive records from the [FTP Folder Monitor](#) log file.

Fixes

- Fixed an issue with [COBREPLACE](#) not replacing the last character in the string if the previous character was replaced.
- Fixed issue with [Advanced Reformatter Trailer \(*TRL\)](#) records not being output when using a [*KEY call](#).
- Fixed issue when using **%ATTACHMENT** in the **Message** for an [Email Output Device](#), where the email message body was cut off when using Greek text due to it expanding when being translated to UTF-8.
- Removed the limit of 13,000 records on the [DSTAPI](#) file.
- Fixed issue when viewing the [Cobwebb Message Queue](#) via the Web Interface where it is failing to show results when there are too many pages to display.
- **Docstore** fixes:
 - Return a better error message if the Docstore API fails to write a record.
 - Special characters are now accepted in passwords when logging in to Docstore.
 - Dates shown in brackets in the document metadata now display the date using the browser locale setting instead of defaulting to DD/MM/YYYY.
 - Deleting a document now correctly displays a message saying it has been deleted.
 - Docstore Log entry not created when filename is greater than 64 characters.
 - All entries now trimmed to fit log field lengths.

- An error is now reported if for any reason the log record cannot be created.

Enhancements

- The **Cobwebb Server** [System Installation Wizard](#) now allows you to install / upgrade a library other than CPPD.
- There is a new option to put **%ATTACHMENT** in the **Message** for an [Email Output Device](#), which allows you to design a PPD to output the information in the **Message Body** rather than adding it as an attachment to an Email.
- The ***PAGE** call in [COBSPLATR](#) now also returns the Number of Copies, CCSID, Character Set and Codepage.
- The **Print removed entries** and **Delete records** defaults for [CLRPPDQ](#) have been changed to ***NONE** and **Y** respectively.
- The **Replace existing save file** default for [SAVPPDQ](#) has been changed to ***YES**.
- The **Replace existing save file** and **Print removed entries** defaults for [RGZPPDQ](#) & the [Save & Clear the CPPD Queue Schedule housekeeping](#) option, have been changed to ***YES** and ***NONE** respectively.
- **Docstore** enhancements include:
 - o Better [searching in Docstore](#) to enable searching by Date, as time is no longer required.
 - o The **Advanced Search** uses predictive text so as you type into a key field matching entries will be displayed in a list.
 - o Handle special characters like / in a **Docstore Name** and **Document Type Name**.

Fixes

- When starting the CPPD subsystem a missing Output Queue prevented all subsequent Spooled File Monitors from starting. Now you will see a **SPLMONERR** job in the CPPD subsystem for the failed entry and all subsequent entries start correctly.
- The [Folder Monitor](#) subsystem job(s) now sends a message to **QSYSOPR** if it cannot find the folder being monitored, with the opportunity to Retry once the path has been re-established.
- When upgrading CPPD, if the upgrade needed to move Data Queues out of the CPPD library into QUSRSYS, the move failed due to a decimal data error on a new field.
- Every once in a while the **PCSRVI** job failed due to the error "accept() failed: Operation would have caused the process to be suspended." The program has been updated so that it does not quit when the accept() call fails, instead it sleeps and then goes back to listening.
- The [Spool File Housekeeping](#) no longer fails when an Output Queue is empty.

- Fixed issues in [ADVRFMT](#) where:
 - page numbering was not working when no Detail (*DET) lines supplied.
 - it fails to find the SPLATR data area when called outside of a Cobwebb PPD.

New Folder Monitor Programs

Post XML to a Web Service

The [FMWEBXML](#) Folder Monitor, to be used with the ***WEB** Folder Monitor Type, allows you to automatically post **XML** files to a **Web Service** based on the configured parameters for the Monitor Type and save the **Response XML** to a chosen location. This has been designed to work using the format of the **.IDX** files produced by the [COBFILIDX](#) program.

Folder Monitor Notifications

There is a new Folder Monitor program [FMNOTIFY](#) that will write a record of the **File Path**, **Folder Monitor Name** & **Date Time stamp** to a Folder Monitor Notifications file.

This information can be printed using the command [FMNOTIFYP](#) where you may override the **Spooled File Output Queue**, **Library** and **User Data**. Running the command will Print & Delete this information and will skip to a new page on change in **Folder Monitor Name**. The command can be scheduled to run, as often as you wish, via the [Cobwebb Job Scheduler](#). This print can then be processed by a Cobwebb PPD to send an email with the details to the relevant person which can be useful if you wish to monitor a "failed" folder.

New Spool-a-matic versions

Spool-a-matic versions **V2R8M0** (for OS V7R2M0) and **V2R7M0** (for OS V7R1M0), together with their PTFs, have been included in this release. See [Installing Spool-a-matic](#) for details on how to install / upgrade.

New Cobwebb Exit Programs

- [COBRAND](#) will generate a random string of characters based on; a supplied string of characters to choose from; length of string to return.

- [COBXLATE](#) will allow you to convert up to 4 fields from their Source CCSID (Coded Character Set Identifier) to a different Target CCSID.
- [COBFNDRET](#) is the fixed version of COBFINDRET which has an issue in that you need to specify the Offset and Return String lengths as one greater than you want.
- [COBPPDATR](#) will retrieve the PPD attributes for the PPD currently being processed. At present this is just the PPD Name.
- [COBADDTIM](#) will allow you to add Hours, Minutes or Seconds to a specified Starting Time.
- [ADVRSTYLE](#) is an add-on to the [Advanced Reformatting Utility](#) for Infor customers who have the Style Module. Invoices and Orders have the Size and Quantity information written as three entries per line in the format Size / Quantity. **ADVRSTYLE** allows you to output this information in a more tabular format with the option of configuring the number of buckets (columns) you wish to have on each line.

Enhancements

- **Cobwebb Docstore** will now allow you to download the [Search Results](#) to a .zip file in the **Downloads** folder.
- The **Cobwebb Designer** (v8 build 13 onwards) has a new option to [Translate Variable Names](#). This is useful if your Codepage is not 1146 - United Kingdom, you are using Variable names with odd characters (e.g. @G_ Global Variables) and either outputting or comparing these variables. See [Multiple Variable & Parameter substitution](#).
- The [Advanced Reformatting Utility](#) now writes information to the [PPD Statistics](#).
- [COBCOUNT](#) has been enhanced to allow you to specify the length of the returned counter and if you would like leading zeros.
- [CHGTSTMOD](#) has a new option of ***JOB** for both the **Test Mode** and **Trace Mode** parameters which will use the current **U7** or **U8** setting for the job respectively.
- Prevent [LREFUPD](#) & [AUPLUPD](#) from writing SQL 02000 errors to the joblog when no records are found to process.
- [WRKGEND](#) command has been enhanced to supply **Filters** for Key 1, 2 and or 3. This then restricts the user to only maintaining records matching the supplied filter.

Fixes

- Fixed issues in the Cobwebb Server upgrade
 - where the **SMTP Email User name** and **Password** were not being copied across.
 - when moving **Data Queues** from library **CPPD** to **QUSRSYS**.
- Fixed issue in [Work with Spooled File Monitor](#) for a new installation where it is not populating the PPD File Name and Library.
- Change [FTPSSEND](#) to use "LOCSITE NAMEFMT 1" instead of "NAMEFMT 1" to prevent FTP 502 error.
- Fixed issue where [COBFILIDX](#) was failing to create the .idx file.
- Fixed issue where [COBSPLIT](#) was failing to return the last word if only 1 character long.
- Fixed issues in [ADVRFMT](#) where
 - a ***WRITE** call was only honouring the ***DETY / *DETN** page throw options for the first output line, **but not for subsequent lines if the call writes multiple lines**.
 - page numbering was not working when no Detail (***DET**) lines supplied.
- Fixed issues in **Docstore** where you cannot
 - delete a document with an apostrophe in the filename

New Cobwebb XML to Spool

As part of the [Cobwebb XML](#) module we now have **Cobwebb XML to Spool** which will take an XML file and re-format and print selected information to a spooled file. Requires OS V6R1M0 or above.

There is a [Work with XML Cross References](#) menu option where you can import your XML file(s), generate **XML Cross References** to the data and decide which pieces of information you require to be output and where on the spooled file you wish to place them. **Cobweb XML to Spool** will handle multiple rows of information such as Item lines as well as multiple documents within one XML. You can configure the position and length of the data that you wish to be output and numeric data will be right justified so that it lines up correctly on the output. There is also a print option so that you can print your output to check that it looks correct.

The XML can be picked up by the [Cobwebb Folder Monitor](#), using the new [FMXML2SPL](#) to convert it using one of your **XML Cross Reference** entries, and generate a spooled file which in turn can then be picked up and processed via a **Cobwebb PPD** and distributed via any of the standard Cobwebb outputs such as Print, Fax, Email and File (Archiving).

New Cobwebb Hot Keys

There is a new [Cobwebb Hot Keys menu](#) which may be accessed using option **86** from the main CPPD menu.

Using **Cobwebb Hot Keys** allows 5250 users, who do not have a GUI Interface (e.g. Infor Workspace), to access their **Cobwebb Docstore** documents from their applications. Whilst this requires no extra software or scripts to be installed onto the users PC, you will need to add a **Function Key** and **Call** to the [Docstore Hot Key program](#) to any application from which you wish to access the Cobwebb Docstore. Requires the [Cobwebb Docstore](#) module for the Docstore Hot Key program to run.

Compatible Browsers

The following web browsers have been successfully tested:

- Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, Microsoft Internet Explorer

Limitations

- Microsoft Edge is not supported as it does not allow for passing the URL as a parameter.
- Due to the IBM i only supporting up to 123 Characters for the PC command, thought must be taken to keep Key Names short when designing the Docstore environment.
- To be able to use Docstore Hot Keys you will need access to the program source code and corresponding display files in order to modify these to add the required information.

How it Works

When a configured Function Key is pressed on a screen it will build a URL, based on the supplied information configured via [Work with Docstore Hot Keys](#), and then invoke the

selected web browser. The URL can be configured to select data from the program, such as an Invoice or Customer number, or non-program data such as the LDA (Local Data Area) that may hold information such as the Company Number. You can also select which of the compatible browsers you wish to use. Client Access will then run a DOS command on the PC that in turn will open the browser and display the matching Docstore records.

Work with Spooled File Monitor

Total revamp of the [Work with Spooled File Monitor](#) program to include the following new functionality:

- **Option 5** - to display the full details for the entry.
- **Option 7** - to turn a Monitor **Online/Offline** from the main list.
- **Option 9** - to add a new **Label** line, This is a line of data that is just holding static text and is used to help group Monitors together.
- You can mix alpha and numeric characters in the **Sequence number**. If you use numeric only the system will right-justify the number to help keep the order.
- **F11** Function Key to display a different view of the list showing details of the Data Queue Name, which is also the Job name in the CPPD subsystem.
- Option to **Filter** the list by **Output Queue, Data Queue** or both.
- New entries to enable [TRACE](#) or [TEST](#) modes which will be picked up by the matching entry running in the CPPD subsystem.
- New entry to set the **Maximum number of spooled file pages** for a monitor. If set, and the number of pages in the spooled file being processed is greater than the value, then the spooled file will not be processed.
- When changing the **Data Queue** for an entry you will be told how many other entries this will affect i.e. using the same Output Queue.
- The **CPPD Subsystem Status** is displayed on the top right of the screen.
- When selecting options the program will return to the same page in the list and not redisplay the first page each time.

Create a Copy of your CPPD library

- New [CRTSTLIB](#) command to create a copy of your existing **CPPD** library and restore it as a new name. It will also change all of the necessary objects such as the CPPD Subsystem name and Job Description to be the same as your new library name as well as making sure they all point to the new library. **Note:** The **CPPD** folder in **QDLS** will also be copied and a new folder created with the same name as your new CPPD Library.

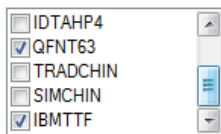

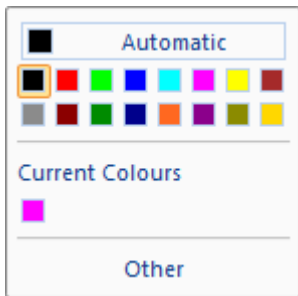

Fixes

- **AFAXDOC** and **AEMLD** no longer have a member for each message. All messages now stored in one member with the message reference as the key. This removes the issue when the maximum number of members is reached.
- Fixed various issues with **Work with Output Devices**.
- Fixed issue where the fax queue can bottleneck when more than one fax is being sent to the same destination.
- Add SPLAMATIC V2R5M0 for OS400 V6R1M0 or later.
